2026 Scholarship Application

As superior scholarship needs to be recognized, the Lodge has established a Student Merit scholarship Fund to recognize and reward academic excellence in our youth. All scholarship awards will be allocated on an objective basis as the applicant must be a high school graduate who has been accepted into, or is a student currently attending an accredited college, university or vocational technical school as a full-time undergraduate student and shall have an academic grade point average of 3.0 or greater, based on a 4.0 grading system.

In addition, the Lodge Scholarship Program is open to all sons, daughters, granddaughters, grandsons or legally established guardians of all Living Lodge members in good standing.

The applicant must apply in writing to the Lodge Scholarship Chairman, indicating their grade point average and a statement indicating why they should be considered for this scholarship program. They must also identify their sponsoring Lodge member and his/her relationship with that member.

Applications must be postmarked and returned to the Lodge Secretary no later than **Thursday, April 16, 2026**, at the following address:

General Instructions:

1. You must use the current year's official application. Changes are sometimes made in the information required. Applications from previous years will not be considered.
2. Complete all information. We will not consider incomplete applications.
3. Include required attachments:
 - a. Transcript or copy of grades from your most recent completed academic year.
4. Sign and date the application.
5. It must be postmarked and returned by the deadline of **Thursday, April 16, 2026**. No applications received after this date will not be considered.

2026 Scholarship Application Guidelines

Applicant Qualifications:

1. Applicant must be a son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter or an established legal guardianship of a living member in good standing of Franklin/St. John's/Trinity Lodge No. 221.
2. Applicant must be a US citizen and a high school graduate or have a certified GED diploma who has been accepted into or is a student currently attending an accredited university, college, or vocational technical school as a full-time undergraduate student. The applicant must be between the age of 18 and 24.
3. Applicant will also be required to submit with a valid application, copies of a student ID, and a certified copy of a transcript from the recognized accredited institution. In lieu of a student ID, the applicant will submit a notarized letter of acceptance to the accredited certified learning institution.
4. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or higher based on a 4.0 GPA grading system.
5. Those applicants qualifying for the Scholarship award will be asked to appear at a Stated Meeting of the Lodge to accept the award check, (date to be determined by the Worshipful Master). In lieu of attendance, the successful applicant must submit a letter verifying receipt of the award.
6. Recipients may apply annually for up to four (4) years of undergraduate education.
